Canada as hosts will receive an automatic entry. The remaining 9 places will be offered to the 9 National Paralympic Committees of the Member Associations of the WCF who have gained the most qualifying points from the World Wheelchair Curling Championship (WWhCCs) held in 2007, 2008, and 2009.

Points are awarded according to final ranking of the 10 participating teams in WWhCCs as follows:

12 – 10 – 8 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1

At the 2007 WWhCCs, teams sharing the same win/loss record at the end of the competition were awarded an equal share of the points available. At the 2008 and 2009 WWhCCs, where teams shared the same win/loss record at the end of the competition, and where the record of games between or among teams did not clearly determine a ranking, the results of the Draw Shot Challenge were used to determine the ranking and distribution of Olympic Qualification Points.
